

Your Car Parking Payment Choices

When On arrival or as you leave

How By cash at any machine. By debit/credit card at machine at entrance to multi storey car park.

Who All who park a vehicle on site with the exception of blue badge holders – see next section.

Monthly Visitor/ Patient Parking Permits

If you regularly attend Sunderland Royal Hospital as a patient or a visitor, you can purchase a discounted monthly car parking permit from the Main Reception.

Registered Disabled Persons

Parking bays for Blue Badge holders are located outside the main entrances. Holders must register with CHS Security to ensure free parking by:

- Contacting the Sunderland Royal Security Office adjacent to Main Reception at the Kayll Road Entrance in person or by telephone extension 49185.
- Using one of the dedicated telephone facilities situated at most main entrances to the hospital. You can register immediately after parking.
- Completing the online registration form at www.chsft.nhs.uk

Parking Charge Notice

Cars not parked in an authorised bay or parked without a ticket or permit will be issued with a Parking Charge notice.
